## FIVE WAYS TO TAKE ACTION

### **Write a letter to the editor using Darfur Report Cards**

Visit [www.darfurreportcards.com](http://www.darfurreportcards.com) to find your elected official's "Darfur Score" - the grade he or she has received based on their support or inaction on important Darfur and genocide -related legislation. Then, write a letter to your local newspaper using your representative's Darfur Score as a tool for pushing him or her to do more for Darfur. Does your rep have a high score already? Write a letter anyways, thanking him/her for scoring so high, and asking for continued action.

### **Call your elected officials on 1-800-GENOCIDE!**

Our elected officials have the power to stop this genocide! call 1800GENOCIDE today, enter in your zipcode, and you'll receive up-to-date talking points on all genocide legislation that your elected official can support and sponsor. Then you'll be patched through directly to your elected official's office - for free! Call today!

### **Donate to the ONLY civilian protection program on the ground in Darfur**

At present, the African Union Mission in Sudan - with just 7,000 troops in an area the size of Texas - is the only force in Darfur charged with protecting civilians. GI-Net's civilian protection program, the only program of its kind in Darfur, works with community leaders, displaced women and girls, and AMIS in order to establish security patrols to accompany women who must leave the camps in order to gather firewood. Money donated to GI-Net's civilian protection program directly protects women and girls in North Darfur from imminent rape and attack.
